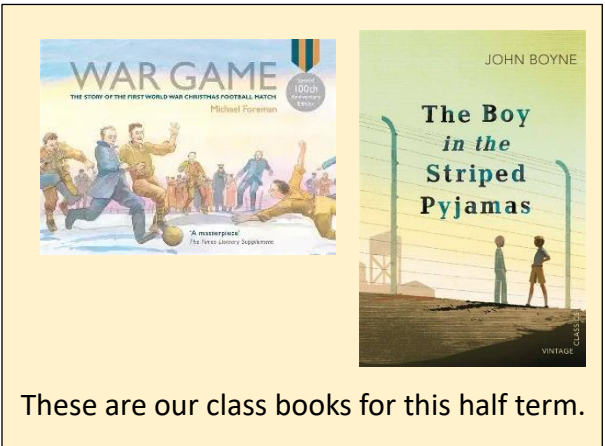
Achieving Excellence Together with God's Love
