

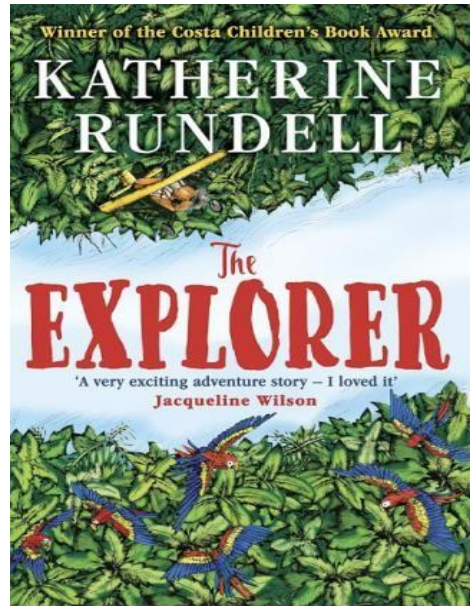


# Year 6 Newsletter

  - How can we make a difference?

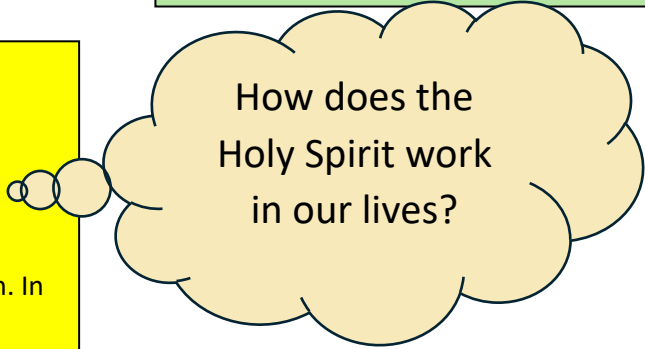
This is our class text for Summer 1. We will also be using this text in some of our Book Talk sessions and to inspire our writing.
