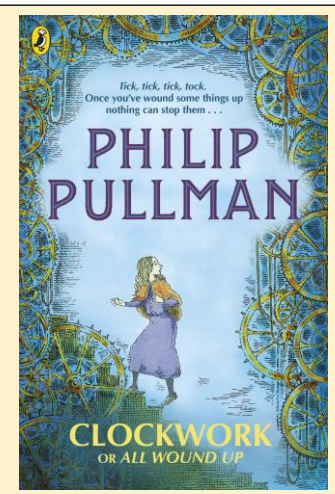
Religious Education

As well as finding out more about Catholic Social Teaching and how we can apply this in our lives, we will also be learning about Hinduism as we encounter others.

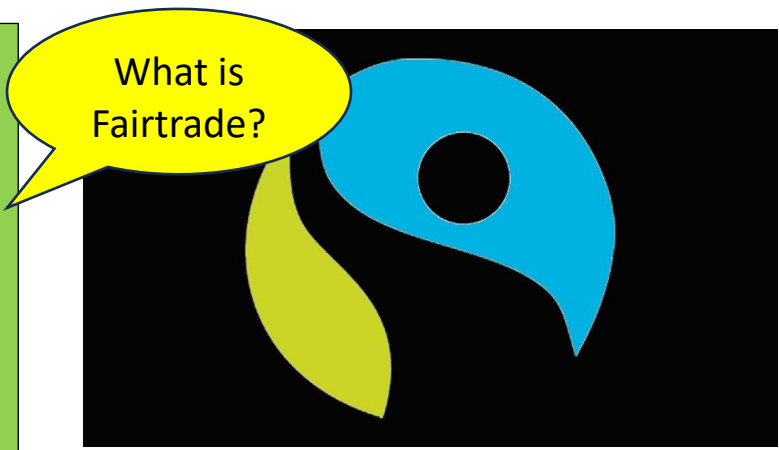
How can we work together to build a fairer and more just world?
