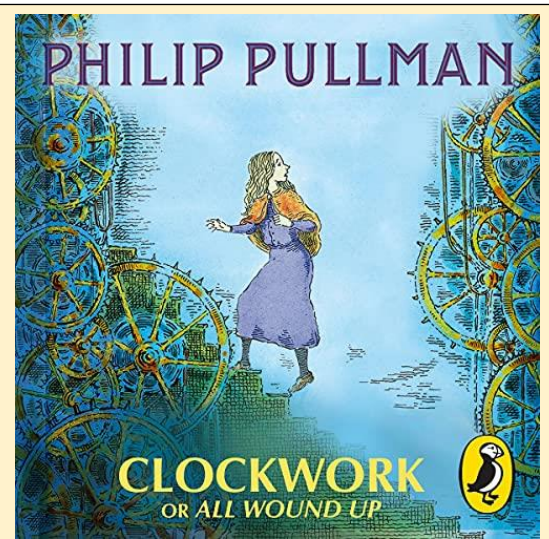

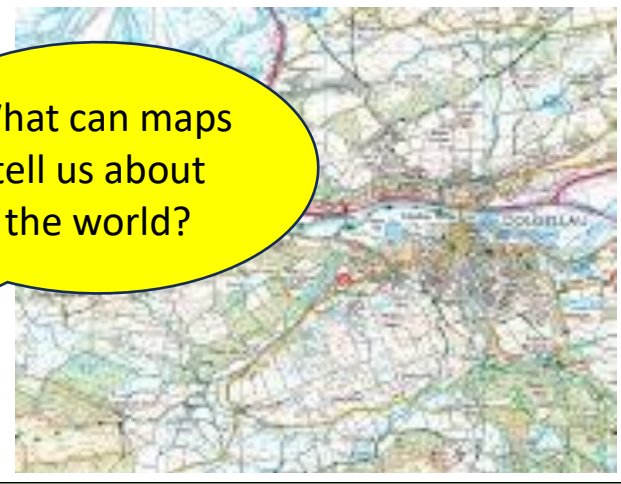
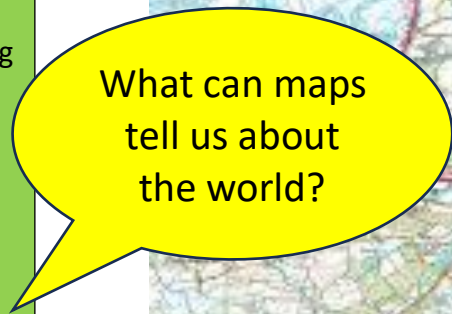


This is our class book for this half term. We will be using it for Book Talk and also to help inspire our writing.
