What is the continent of Europe like?

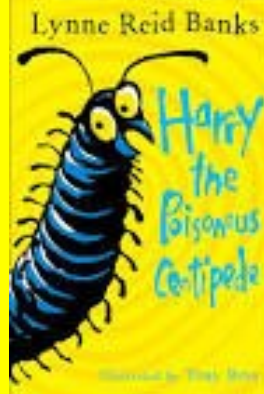


What is the continent of North America like?
