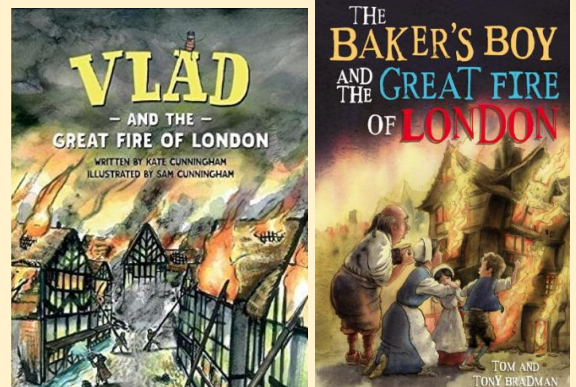
Religious Education
