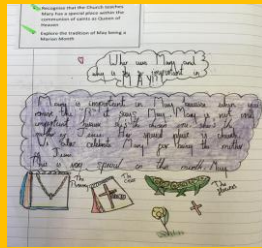

Thank you to our Chaplaincy Team who continue to lead the spiritual life of the school by sharing the Gospel, leading Celebrations of the Word and prayer.



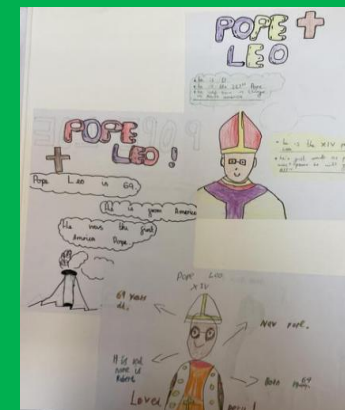
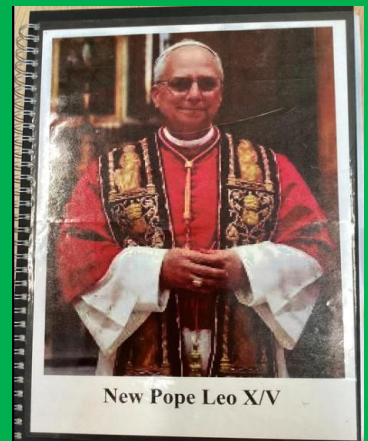
## Holy Door of Hope
