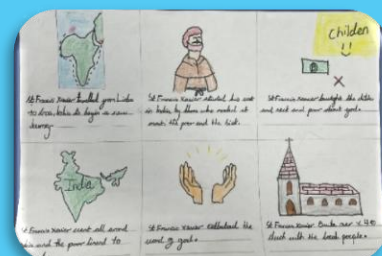


Remembrance Day
